

Red Dog Farm Picking Crew Positions 2012

Red Dog Farm is a 23-acre organic farm with 13 acres in vegetable and berry production. Located on the Olympic Peninsula, Red Dog Farm is nestled in the beautiful Center Valley of Chimacum, Washington. We produce crops year-round and sell to three local farmers markets, to local restaurants and wholesalers, through our CSA program, and at our own farmstand on the farm. Red Dog Farm is going into its fifth season with farm owner/ operator Karyn Williams. Laura Llewellyn, field crew manager, joins us for her second season.

We are currently advertising for four part time picking crew positions for the 2012 season. Applications are accepted any time after April 1, 2012 and will be reviewed on an on-going basis until the positions are filled.

Compensation is hourly wage of \$9 per hour plus fresh produce from our fields.

Time Commitment

- Picking Crew positions begin as early as June 15th and as late as August 15th.
- Time commitment will be negotiated before hiring and is at a minimum through the end of September.
- The hours are Tuesdays and Fridays 7am until we're done, which is usually until 5pm, but sometimes as late as 8pm.

Essential Job Functions

- The primary responsibility is to pick loose greens, strawberries, peas, beans, and cut flowers and to move irrigation pipe.

Minimum Qualifications

- Preference given to those who do not need days off and have demonstrated perfect attendance at previous jobs.
- Excellent work ethic and positive attitude.
- Strong back required.
- Ability to kneel and bend over all day
- Ability to work in all weather conditions.
- Ability to have a flexible end time each day of work.
- Ability to handle monotonous, strenuous work.
- Ability to commit to staying for the full picking season.
